Have you noticed the changes on the shelves of the church library? First there was a big clean out—and many of the previous books were removed and replaced with newer books. Nearly all the books are now post 1990 publication dates, with many being within the last 10-15 years. The books are now arranged in broad subject areas to make it easier for you to locate your area of interest: Bible, Christian Life, Theology, Ministry and History. The borrowing system is the same—there is a book for you to add your name and phone number, and the name of the book borrowed. There are no limits on borrowing.
